Since starting to mediate on a part time basis in 1999, Paul Marks has mediated almost 1,000 cases covering a wide variety of issues. He retired from the Guglielmo, Marks, Schutte firm at the end of 2013, and has enjoyed being a full time mediator since that time. He earned his JD from Louisiana State University Law School in 1969 (winner of the Flory Trial competition, vice-chair of the Moot Court Board). During his U.S. Army service in Germany and Vietnam, he was a prosecutor and received the Bronze Star. He chaired the Civil Courts Liaison Committee of the Baton Rouge Bar Association for 14 years, served on the board of directors for eight years and was president in 1988-89. He was an adjunct associate law professor at the LSU Paul M. Hebert Law Center from 1978-83, and is a member of the Law Center Hall of Fame. Has been AV-rated by Martindale-Hubbell since 1981. He was a faculty member for the pilot program and first faculty group for the National Institute of Trial Advocacy presentation to LSU Law Center students. He was an ad hoc City Court judge and an original Master of the Henry George McMahon American Inns of Court.
