Small Arbitrations
(Two-Party Claims up to \$25,000)

Small Arbitrations

The matter is billed at flat rate of \$3,500 with up to 5 hours of arbitration time. The claimant will pay a \$500 non-refundable deposit when the arbitration demand is filed, and the respondent will pay a \$500 non-refundable deposit when it files its answer or response to the arbitration demand. The balance of the \$3,500 flat fee must be paid by the parties in equal portions within 30 days of the initial conference with the arbitrator.

If the parties' contract contains an arbitration clause that stipulates a different allocation of arbitration costs (e.g. the party cast with liability must pay 100% of the arbitration costs) then the Arbitrator will allocate arbitration costs in the award, in accordance with the parties' agreement.

Consumer Arbitrations

Consumer Arbitrations will be billed in accordance with the parties' pre-dispute arbitration agreement. If the parties have no such arbitration agreement, the matter will be billed as above.
